# China, Philippines to discuss South China Sea dispute amid clashes

TAIPEI, TAIWAN — As China is set to host bilateral talks with the Philippines this month, their South China Sea dispute is expanding from sea to air, increasing the risk of military confrontation, analysts warn.

The Chinese Communist Party's *People's Daily* newspaper on Monday published an article warning that "China-Philippines relations stand at a crossroads" over the South China Sea dispute.

The warning came after Filipino Foreign Affairs Secretary Enrique Manalo told reporters at a diplomatic reception on September 4 that Beijing will host the next round of the Bilateral Consultative Mechanism meetings designed to manage differences between the two countries.

Manalo did not say on which date the talks would start this month but expressed hope the two countries would discuss an incident in late August when coast guard ships from both sides collided at a disputed shoal. Both countries blame the other for the collision, though video released by the Philippine coast guard appears to show the Chinese coast guard ship ramming their vessel, BRP Teresa Magbanua.

It was the second such collision of their coast guard ships in August at the disputed atoll.

"At present, China-Philippines relations are at a crossroads, facing a choice of where to go. There is no way out of conflict and confrontation, and dialogue and consultation are the right way," the commentary on People's Daily said.

## South China Sea, Philippines, China held talks on territorial disputes

The Philippines and China held "frank and frank" talks on the two countries' territorial disputes in the South China Sea, during which Manila "reaffirmed its position" on the Sabina Shoal, but agreed with Beijing to take measures to reduce tensions in the area, the Philippine Foreign Ministry announced on Monday. The talks, held in China on Thursday, were organized under a consultation mechanism agreed upon by the two countries, which also reaffirmed their commitment to "continue discussions on areas of cooperation, especially on direct communication mechanisms, coast guard cooperation, and cooperation on maritime science and technology," according to a statement released by the ministry.

China-Philippines relations "are certainly at a critical crossroads" and the Manila government "should reconsider its actions in the South China Sea, as they may jeopardize cooperation in various fields and lead to unpredictable consequences," reads the editorial "The Philippines is the Real Troublemaker in the South China Sea," published this week by the People's **Daily** under the pen name "Zhong Sheng" ("Voice of China"), which the paper often uses to express opinions on foreign policy issues. China has always prioritized resolving maritime disputes with the Philippines through "negotiations and consultation to maintain peace and stability in the South China Sea," the People's **Daily** said, noting that Beijing's tolerance "is not infinite."
